The ESF Employability Project has been running since April 2022 in partnership with Moray Pathways, alongside Forres Online's existing

- completing Application Forms
- writing a Covering Letter
- developing your Interview Skills
- getting your identity & right to work evidence ready for starting a new job
- identifying Volunteer Opportunities that can help you to get a job
- helping to find appropriate Training& Wellbeing Activities
- supporting you when starting work

Over the last 9 months:

- just under 500 people have attended our weekly Digital Drop-in Sessions
- 24 people have signed up for the ESF Employability Project & of those:
- 9 people have gained employment
- 2 people started training or education
- -11 Digital Course Certificates have been awarded to participants

The ESF Employability Project has funding for 1 year: 2022-23

Over the next few months FACT will be looking for funding so that we can continue to support people in the Forres Area from April 2023 onwards and help them to find employability and training solutions.
