FACT have recently been successful in being awarded Funding from a wide range of sources to support the Forres Area Community.



Thanks to effective Grant Applications FACT have been awarded over £171,000:

• £50,000 for Insulation for Forres Town Hall from Money for Moray and tsiMORAY's Just Transition Participatory Budgeting Fund.

Thanks again to everyone who voted in the Participatory Budgeting Voting Process which enabled FACT & 12 other Organisations across Moray to get a share of £333,333.

- £35,146.72 to pay for Surveys needed as part of the Forres Town Hall Redevelopment Project from the Berry Burn Community Fund.
- £25,000 for FACT's Forres Pantry from the People's Postcode Trust which is supported by players of the People's Postcode Lottery.
- £20,000 for the Forres Town Hall Redevelopment Project from the Scottish Community Landfill Fund.
- £19,250 to support FACT's **Cameron Project** which helps to reduce Social Isolation in the Forres Academy Catchment Area from the Local Action Fund which is distributed by the Moray Local Action Group.
- £15,000 for Surveys for the Forres Town Hall Redevelopment Project from the Architectural Heritage Fund.
- £5,000 for the Cameron Project from the Crerar Trust
- £2,000 for the Menopause Moments Pilot Project from the tsiMORAY's Community Wellbeing Participatory Grant Making Funding.

Also thanks to everyone who voted in the Participatory Grant Making Voting Process which enabled FACT & 11 other Organisations across Moray to get a share of £20,000.

We really appreciate that many different Funding Partners have recognised the work that FACT does to support the Forres Area Community by awarding us Grants.

This is all in addition to the **£149,907** which was awarded to **FACT** by **The National Lottery Community Fund** to spend over 3 years to support the work undertaken by our Cameron Project, Forres Online & Volunteer Coordinators.
