part time staff. Since
then, there have been
significant changes and
Debbie became the
Development Manager
in 2017.

Over the years the Team has grown to a FACT Staff Team of 15 with 3 full time and 12 part time roles. We all work together to:

make Forres a better place to live, work and visit.

We would like to take the opportunity to thank Debbie for her tireless enthusiasm to support the Community across the Forres Area and to develop the organisation into what it has become today.



FACT was set up to support the Forres Area in the wake of the imminent closure of the RAF Base at Kinloss. As a major employer in the area, this closure had a huge impact on the local community. So a lead organisation was set up to support a partnership of groups that could work together to develop a

cohesive plan for development for the future.

FACT started out by renting an Office in The Tolbooth, and we now own Forres Town Hall thanks to a Community Asset Transfer which was completed in 2021. We are continuing to develop the plans to make the Hall a more accessible and multifunctional space for the whole Community.

Thanks to Debbie's fantastic success rate with Grant Applications, the funds were secured to buy the Town Hall and to pay for essential repairs.

Recently FACT was awarded £300,000 by the
UK Government's Community Ownership Fund as well as
£50,000 as part of the allocation of the
Scottish Government's Just Transition Fund which was
distributed through tsiMORAY & Money for Moray.
These Grants were again thanks to Debbie's
foresight and expertise in applying for Funding that
support FACT and our many Projects.

FACT have been able to achieve so much over the last 6 years with input from Debbie and the Board of Directors who have supported the vision. Here is a BRIEF Summary: establishing Forres Online & The Cameron Project which have improved digital skills & reduced Social Isolation for residents as well as provide Volunteering Opportunities; supporting the Forres Area Local Tourism Initiative & developing & distributing a local Directory of Services; supporting the organisation of the Toun Mercat; taking over the lease of the Town Hall in 2018 when it was closed by Moray Council & completing the CAT in 2021; supporting the Community during Covid by hosting weekly Meetings for local Support Networks; setting up a Food Project & a Mental Health Project during Covid to support residents & businesses; establishing the ESF Employability Project including Digital Training; introducing a Volunteer Coordinator to develop opportunities in the local Area; extending the Cameron Project with 2 different Fitness Classes + Fitness MOTs & an additional 130 Classes & over 1000 extra participants over 12 months thanks to a £10,000 Wellbeing Grant.

Debbie has shared the vision & employed Staff effectively to support the Community.

Thankfully she is available to answer all our questions in the short term before she starts her new role supporting Communities across Scotland. A MASSIVE THANK YOU for all your hard work from the whole Team & for supporting the development of the Forres Area SO WELL.
