We received a donation from **Baxters** of 15 boxes of Traditional Clootie Dumpling Kits via our **Moray Pathways**, **DWP & DYW Partners**. They proved very popular with the customers at our **Forres Pop Up Pantry**. Different surplus food items are donated by large companies each week via **CFine** - **Community Food Initiatives North East** - and the donations are delivered weekly to FACT by Moray Food Plus. Membership is free for anyone who lives in the Forres Academy Catchment Area and you get about £10 worth of food for £2.50.

The Cameron Project has recently started liaising with Wild Things in Findhorn.



Wild Things run a group for the over 65's called the **Silver Saplings**.

The group goes out once a month, on a Friday, and enjoy outings to various places all over Moray. In good weather they have gentle walks in lovely gardens like Brodie Castle and the Forres Wildflower Meadow.

They go bird watching, visit local places of interest like the Clava Cairns

and in the winter months they go to local Museums and Art Centres.

Anyone is welcome to join. Participants are preferably mobile and able to walk a short distance, however people with walking frames and wheelchairs are also welcome. The program is fully funded and the trips are free, although donations can be made. Halfway through the morning tea and cake is provided and participants take a packed lunch with them.
