Welcome to our new Quarterly Newsletter!

As many of you will have seen, building work has started on Forres Town Hall and it is surrounded by scaffolding. FACT was awarded £300,000 of Grant Funding in March 2023 by the UK Government's Community Ownership Fund and we are using this to complete Phase 1 of the the Town Hall Redevelopment Project.

This **Phase** will make the building more energy efficient and help reduce our heating bills which is good news for **FACT** and the environment!



FACT Staff have worked hard to secure £250,000 of additional funding to match the Capital Building Costs for the Project.

This extra match funding has included Grants from:

Highland and Islands Enterprise (HIE) - Green Grant Fund

Moray Local Action Group Fund

Scottish Community Landfill Fund

Just Transition Participatory Budgeting Fund which was delivered by Money for Moray and tsiMORAY



We would also like to thank

AJ Engineeering and Construction
for storing all these rolls of insulation
for FREE for over 10 months while we
raised the funds to complete Phase 1.

Phase 1 has enabled us to start work on making the roof space completely wind and watertight so that the new roof insulation that was bought in 2023 can be fully installed.

The remaining £50,000 from the

Community Ownership Fund Grant
is being used for Professional Fees,
FACT Staff costs to support the
delivery of Phase 1 and other
additional operational costs incurred
while the works are being carried out.

Forres Town Hall Redevelopment - progress so far:

Thanks to previous **Grants** from **Funders** we have been able to carry out vital **Surveys to clarify the current state of the building**. This has included Grants from: **Berry Burn Community Fund**, **Development Trusts Association Scotland** (Green Shoots Fund) and the **Architectural Heritage Fund**



The Surveys have been an essential aspect of the Redevelopment Project and has meant that we could go out to tender for Phase 1 of the Project.

We are pleased to announce that the LTM Group - Laing Traditional Masonry Ltd, were awarded the contract and will be working on the roof and completing remedial work on the dry rot in the FACT Office.

We anticipate that this work, along with the **fitting of the insulation**, will be completed by the end of March 2024.

Representatives of all the Funders who have contributed to the Forres Town Hall Redevelopment Project were invited to have a Hard Hat Tour up on the scaffolding around the building to see how the funds are being spent during Phase 1.

As the UK Government allocate the

Community Ownership Fund and the Scottish

Government allocate the Just Transition Fund

both the MP and MSP for Moray were invited and
so were included in this historic photo opportunity.

They are joined by representatives from Highlands & Islands Enterprise, Money for Moray, the Berry Burn Community Fund and Development Trusts Association Scotland.

The Site Manager from LTM as well as the FACT Chair of the Board showed them the work that is being carried out and discussed the future aims of the Redevelopment Project.



Forres Town Hall is run by FACT on behalf of the local Community.

FACT Members get regular Newsletters and also information about the Courses,

The History of FACT and Forres Town Hall

FACT took over the running of Forres Town Hall in 2018 after Moray Council closed the building in 2017 due to budget cuts. In 2021, FACT bought the building via a Community Assest Transfer thanks to a Grant from the Scottish Land Fund so the building could remain a focal point for the community in the Forres Area.

Since then we have developed a number of strategies to raise funds for the Forres Town Hall Redevelopment Project.

As we were not successful in our 2022/23 Application for £3 million to the Regeneration Capital Grant Fund, we have decided to complete the Project in phases instead.

We are thrilled to have started Phase 1 of the Redevelopment Project.



The current estimate for the total
Project is now £5 million to
make the building fully accessible to
all members of our community and
to reduce the running costs.

This in turn, will help **FACT** keep hire charges for rooms and halls as low as possible.

There are **many more Bookings** since 2017 and lots of people have told us that they are thrilled that the Town Hall is such a busy place now!

We are grateful that so many **Funders** have **recognised our ambition** to redevelop **Forres Town Hall** and have awarded us **Grants**.
